**RULE 5 - FIRST CLAIM STATUS – The competition year extends from 1st October to 30th September in the following year.**

**RULE 207 (iii) Under 17 Women road running competitions for under 17s shall be confined to competitors who are aged 15 or 16 on 31<sup>st</sup> August prior to the commencement of the competition year as defined above.**

**RULE 216(6) WILL APPLY**

**CLOTHING: All** team runners **must** wear the same design of registered Club vest and Colours, unless the referee has given permission for a change to be made.

Any advertising or sponsorship on clothing must comply with UK Athletics Rule 16.

**Midland Counties Athletic Association Qualification:** An athlete is eligible to represent his/her Club in Midland Championships either by:

- A. By birth,
- B. By 9 months bona fide continuous residence within the regional boundary immediately prior to the date of competition,
- C. By 9 month’s service in HM forces stationed within the regional boundary,
- D. By first claim membership of an affiliated Club with headquarters within the regional boundary,
- E. A member of the England Athletics membership scheme

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**RULE 207 (i) Under 13 boys and girls road running competitions for under 13s shall be confined to competitors who are aged 11 on the day of competition or 12 on 31<sup>st</sup> August prior to the commencement of the competition year as defined above.**

**RULE 207 (ii) Under 15 boys and girls road running competitions for under 15s shall be confined to competitors who are aged 13 or 14 on the day of competition on 31<sup>st</sup> August prior to the commencement of the competition year as defined above.**

**RULE 207 (iii) Under 17 men and Women road running competitions for under 17s shall be confined to competitors who are aged 15 or 16 on the day of competition on 31<sup>st</sup> August prior to the commencement of the competition year as defined above.**

**RULE 207 (iv) (v) Junior Men & Women who are aged 17, 18 or 19 on 31 August prior to the commencement of the competition year as defined above may take part in Road Relay competitions and compete in Senior events.**
