

MID LANCS MEDAL MEETING

Saturday 24th August 2024, Stanley Park Arena, Blackpool

Hammer 11 am start. Other Field events and Track 12 noon start (after which starting times may not be announced).

- The meeting will be held under UKA and Mid Lancs Rules
- Entries are online only. £12 for 3 events. Entries will close on Sunday 18th August
- Entries are online: www.race-results.co.uk
- Relay teams Entry on the day £9 per team
- Athletes must have competed in at least 2 meetings during the 2024 League season to be eligible to receive medals; but can otherwise compete.
- Licensed guests may enter online. £18 for 3 events. Guests will not be eligible to receive a medal.
- Numbers (different to League numbers) are to be collected on the day by the team manager from each club.
- Events are as normal Mid Lancs fixtures except: the 3,000 metres is not a team race all will run together but will receive separate age group awards, u15, u17, senior.
- U20 Male athletes may throw their u20 weight implement in Shot, Hammer and Discus, but will not be eligible for a medal. All u20 athletes will compete with seniors.
- Clubs must not run athletes of different age groups in a relay team except u17 & seniors
- League Rules regarding provision of Officials by Clubs apply to the Medal Meeting. In the interests of safety, events may be cancelled if insufficient Officials are available to conduct the competition.
