

#### **AGE LIMITS**

Under 11 Boys & Girls – Y5 and Y6 scholars on the day of the race (4 Jan 2025)

Under 13 Boys & Girls - 11 on the day (4 Jan 2025) and under 13 on 1 Sept 2024

Under 15 Boys & Girls - under 15 on 1 Sept 2024

Under 17 Men & Women - under 17 on 1 Sept 2024

Under 20 Men & Women - under 20 on 1 Sept 2024

Senior Men & Women - 20 or over on 1 Sept 2024

Masters Men (M35, M45, M55, M65, M75+) - ages on the day of the race (4 Jan 2025)

Masters Women (W35, W45, W55, W65) – ages on the day of the race (4 Jan 2025)

## **TEAMS**

There will be team races in most age groups. Three to score in all races except Senior/Masters Women where four to score irrespective of age groups; Senior Men, five to score; and the Masters Men four to score, irrespective of individual Masters age category. No team entry fees - enter as individuals.

The electronic entry system will highlight athlete affiliation and those not affiliated. Please ensure that your profile details are correct at the time of entry.

### **ENTRY FEES**

Under 11, Under 13, Under 15, Under 17, Under 20, Seniors, Masters £10.00. Payment via the online entry system. Those entrants that do not have an up to date England Athletics Affiliation will be required to pay £15. No entry fees will be refunded under any circumstances

#### **Further Information**

- > ALL runners MUST have been born in the City of Derby or County of Derbyshire or, have been resident in the County for at least 9 months or, based in the County as a member of HM Forces before the date of the Championships. Runners are ineligible if they have competed in another County's Championships in the current Competition Year
- All runners are to wear club/school kit, County, Area, National or, International vests. Athletes wearing any other vest risk being disqualified unless they have the Referee's permission. *First claim Club vests only should be worn for the team races*.
- ➤ Derbyshire medals will be awarded to the first three individuals in each race except for each Masters age group 8+ entries 3 medals, 4-7 entries 2 medals, 1 3 entries 1 medal. Medals will be awarded to the first three teams in each age group.
- Numbers to be collected <u>only by an age group Club/School Team Manager</u> on the day. Age Group Team Managers to collect numbers by 11:30 am at the latest.
- > A Timetable will be available on www.derbyshireathletics.org.uk. Entrants will be listed on the entry system.

The UKA Anti-Doping Rules apply to entrants participating in the sport of Athletics, for 12 months from the date of entry, whether or not the entrant is a citizen of, or resident in, the UK.
