LANCASHIRE CROSS COUNTRY TEAM SELECTION

The first 6 finishers in the following races will qualify for automatic selection for the Inter Counties team (date and venue to be decided)

- U13 Boys & Girls, U15 Boys & Girls, U17 Men & Women with 2 other places to be decided at team manager's discretion.
- Senior Men & Women with 3 other places to be decided at team manager's discretion.

The first 3 finishers in the U20 Men's and Women's races will also have automatic selection with 5 other places to be decided at team manager's discretion. U20s seeking selection must be under 20 for the whole of the competition year i.e. age at midnight December 31st 2025
